HCC Services include:

- Admission to service is based on nursing assessment and reassessment
- Case management and referrals to other services
- Home Care nursing services, care planning and teaching self care
- Personal Care Aide services including bathing, grooming, dressing, foot care, and supportive care
- Assistance/liaison with respite and palliative care
- Assistance with mobility and activities of daily living
- Medication monitoring
- Assistance with access to medical equipment
- Discharge from the program when goals are met

In addition to the physical aspects of treatment, we believe in education, nutritional support, and wellness planning. Foot care services are limited to assessment, teaching, soaking, filing of nails, and massage. If assessment reveals a foot problem, visiting a podiatrist will be recommended. Maintaining a healthy diet and getting plenty of exercise is important for longevity. It is never too late to start a healthy lifestyle. While proper foot care is important for people of all ages, it is especially important for seniors and people with diabetes.
